**LANGUAGE IMPLEMENTATION PLAN 2022**

### **1. Introduction/Context**

The Faculty supports the principle of multilingualism<sup>1</sup> without exclusion, acknowledging the value of cultural, linguistic and other forms of diversity in the Faculty as an asset in epistemological, pedagogical, research, administrative and social contexts. The Faculty's Language Implementation Plan is based on the principle of ensuring that language does not form a barrier to access and optimal learning and teaching at Stellenbosch University. The Faculty is committed to flexible combinations of languages, specifically English, Afrikaans and isiXhosa, as contextually appropriate to specific lectures, seminars, tutorials, practicals, and administration. Such combinations facilitate inclusivity through diversity. This Language Implementation Plan (LIP) was initially drafted during a strategic planning session of departmental chairpersons and vice-deans on 30 November 2015, finalised in December 2015 and tabled at the Faculty Board on 17 February 2016. The 2022 version was circulated to departmental chairpersons for input from staff about possible revision. The feedback was discussed at a Chairs meeting on 15 October 2021 where the chair of the BA Student Committee was also present, and the consensus was that the LIP should remain unchanged for 2022. We acknowledge that the Language Implementation Plan presently emphasises the ideals of multilingualism, rather than materialising in practice the equitable use of the three languages foregrounded in the faculty. We commit to finding ways in which to see isiXhosa, English and Afrikaans sharing a more egalitarian relation in teaching and learning, so as to assist student success.

### **2. Aims of LIP and promotion of multilingualism**

The Language Implementation Plan of the Faculty promotes:

- Excellence in teaching, research and social impact
- Multilingualism as a graduate-attribute
- Student success
- A welcoming and inclusive culture
- Access to the Faculty
- Respect for diversity among students and staff
- Flexible solutions for any challenges of multilingualism

Multilingualism is promoted through:

- The provision of module outlines in English and in Afrikaans
- The provision of class notes and/or slides in English and in Afrikaans
- The presentation of lectures, tutorials and practicals in either double medium or parallel medium

<sup>1</sup> In this document, *multilingualism* refers to the ability of a person to have access to, and work fairly comfortably in more than one language. It stands in contrast to *monolingualism* which entails that a person can only speak one language.

- The active encouragement of students to become familiar with difficult ideas and thought processes by speaking in their preferred language, and calling on peers for translation and interpretation in the classroom space
- The provision of tutorial and practical material in English and in Afrikaans
- The setting of tests and exams in English and in Afrikaans, with students having the option to formulate their answers in either language
- The appointment of student assistants / tutors with multilingualism in mind
- The appointment of English/Afrikaans/isiXhosa tutors/mentors in the Faculty's EDP program
- The provision of interpretation services in English/Afrikaans/isiXhosa in the Faculty's EDP program
- The development of five discipline specific terminology glossaries in English/Afrikaans and isiXhosa

### **3. Language use in teaching and learning**

The aims stated above ensure that communication regarding teaching, learning and administration will be available in English and Afrikaans, with provision made for the use and development of isiXhosa as a language of tuition and administration. The details of the implementation of this goal will be determined by the realities of the pedagogical and administrative space, such as in specific language disciplines. These realities also include student needs and the linguistic abilities of staff.

The goal stated above means that undergraduate students can study in both English and Afrikaans, with teaching staff providing access to learning material in more than one language. In the pedagogical space, the implementation comprises the following, taking into consideration the realities of specific language disciplines:

- 3.1 For undergraduate modules where it is reasonably practicable and pedagogically sound to have more than one class group:
  - 3.1.1 There are separate lectures in Afrikaans and English.
  - 3.1.2 Learning opportunities, such as group work, assignments, tutorials and practicals involving students from both language groups are utilised to promote integration within programmes.
  - 3.1.3 Students are supported in Afrikaans and English during a combination of appropriate, facilitated learning opportunities (e.g. consultations during office hours or scheduled tutorials and practicals).
- 3.2 For undergraduate modules where both Afrikaans and English are used in the same class group, the combination of facilitated learning opportunities is as follows:
  - 3.2.1 During each lecture, all information is conveyed at least in English and summaries or emphasis on content are also given in Afrikaans. Questions in Afrikaans and English are, at the least, answered in the language of the question.
  - 3.2.2 Students are supported in Afrikaans and English during a combination of appropriate, facilitated learning opportunities (e.g. consultations during office hours, or scheduled tutorials and practicals).
  - 3.2.3 For first-year modules, SU makes simultaneous interpreting available during each lecture. During the second and subsequent years of study, simultaneous interpreting is made available by SU upon request by a faculty, if the needs of the students warrant the service and SU has the resources to provide it. If two weeks have passed with no students making use of the interpreting service, it may be discontinued.

3.3 In the following instances, lectures will be offered in one language only:

3.3.1 Where the nature of the subject matter of the module justifies doing so, for example where the module is on the language itself.

3.3.2 Where the assigned lecturer is proficient to teach only in Afrikaans or English. For these modules additional support is provided:

(a) If the lectures are in Afrikaans, SU makes simultaneous interpreting available in English. If the lectures of the first-year modules are in English, SU makes simultaneous interpreting available in Afrikaans; and during the second and subsequent years of study, simultaneous interpreting is made available by SU upon request by a Faculty, if the needs of the students warrant the service and SU has the resources to provide it. If two weeks have passed with no students making use of the interpreting service, it may be discontinued.

(b) In addition to lectures, there are appropriate, facilitated learning opportunities (e.g. consultations during office hours, or routinely scheduled tutorials and practicals) in Afrikaans and English.

3.3.3 Where all the students in the class group have been invited to vote by means of a secret ballot and those students who have voted, agree unanimously to it, the module will be presented in Afrikaans only or English only, provided that the relevant lecturers and teaching assistants have the necessary language proficiency and agree to do so.

#### **4. Language in administration**

For administrative purposes, communication is conducted in both English and Afrikaans, with the use of isiXhosa as required and where practicable. This means that:

- All administrative communication with undergraduate students is in both English and Afrikaans (e.g. correspondence from the Dean's Office and departments, information on websites, yearbook entries, promotional material), where practicable and as contextually determined;
- At postgraduate level, English is mostly used;
- Correspondence with and from the Dean's Office and Faculty committees is in both English and Afrikaans, as contextually determined;
- Faculty committee proceedings are in both English and Afrikaans, subject to the principle that all participants must have access to all information;
- Faculty Board meetings are conducted in a flexible manner in English and Afrikaans with participation in English, Afrikaans and isiXhosa. Professional interpreting services are used to ensure that all participants have access to all information and can make contributions in any of these languages.

#### **5. Feedback mechanisms on implementation**

The Faculty in general and the language departments in particular regularly conduct scientific studies on language in relation to teaching practices, student learning, and changing disciplinary parameters. This provides a body of expertise that can guide future decisions on language policy.

Mechanisms for student feedback include specific questions on the practice and experience of the use of language in teaching modules. This feedback is made available to lecturers, departmental chairs and the Dean. Any concerns about language practice are addressed initially with the lecturer.

In their annual performance appraisals, lecturers report on their experience of the Faculty's Language Implementation Plan. Departmental chairs, in turn, report within the framework of their annual departmental action plans to the Dean about best practices and challenges. The Dean uses these reports in drafting the annual Environment Plan for the Faculty.

### **6. Revision of the Faculty's Language Implementation Plan**

The Faculty's Language Implementation Plan is reviewed on an annual basis in conjunction with the Faculty Environment Plan.
